INTBAU is seeking a videographer to document a volunteer programme in Pono village, Sindh, southeast Pakistan. Two groups of volunteers will be hosted in Pono village from 26 March – 4 April and from 9 – 18 April. We are seeking a professional to document one of these workshops.

About

INTBAU was established in 2001 and has since gained more than 35 chapters and 8,000 members in over 150 countries worldwide. We work under the patronage of our founder, HRH The Prince of Wales. INTBAU's mission is to support traditional building, the maintenance of local character, and the creation of better places to live. We do this through workshops, summer schools, study tours, conferences, awards, and competitions. Our three objectives are to research, educate, and engage as widely as possible on the value and relevance of traditional architecture and urban design. INTBAU is a unique, established resource for global knowledge of traditional architecture and urban design. Our active network consists of individuals and institutions who design, make, maintain, study, or enjoy traditional buildings and places.

Programme Context

Pono Eco Village is one of a cluster of 13 villages in the province where 1,000 families have become self-sufficient following the disastrous floods which displaced 33 million people across Pakistan in August 2022.

The programme offers international participants a chance to learn about low carbon construction techniques locals have adopted in this area with the support and guidance of humanitarian architect, Yasmeen Lari. Participants will be offered a choice of practical workshops, along with additional opportunities to experiment, design and build with these materials.
